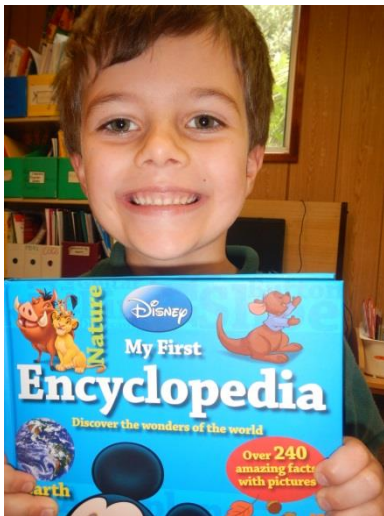
I like my book because Henry sails the bath tub.



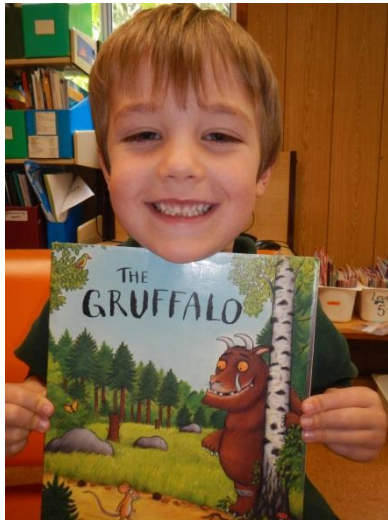
Waterhole is my favourite book because all the animals deink at the waterhole.



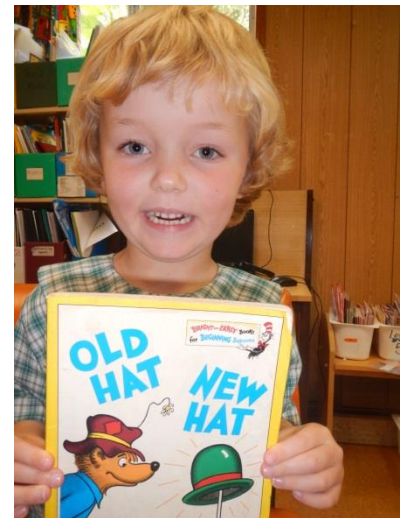
My favourite book is Chester. It is funny. He draws on other peoples pictures



My favourite book is Encyclopedia. I like my book because it has lots of animals.

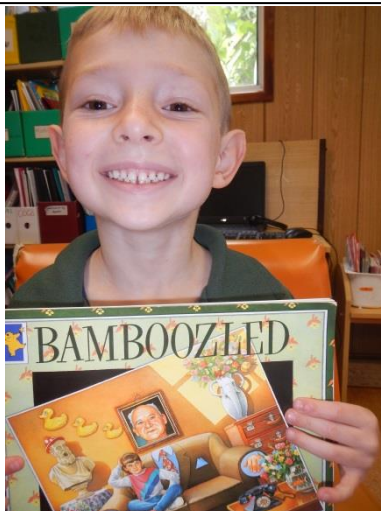


I like my book because I read it every day with my mum and dad. It has a bit of rhythm.
